Amendments have been made in the bidding documents, which are as under: -

4.2.1.1.12	Bids must reach to the Office of Superintending Engineer Gilgit Ghizer Circle near Eid Gah Kondass Gilgit by 23 rd April 2026 at 1130 Hrs and will be opened on the same day at 1200 Hrs.	That the bid submission deadline has been extended up to 16 th June 2026 at 1130 hours on the same venue. All bidders are advised to submit their bids within the extended timeline.
B	EVALUATION CRITERIA:	
5	In case of a Joint Venture (JV) , the agreement must be executed in the proper PEC formats, duly signed by both JV partners, clearly mentioning the share of each Partner (Lead partner and the Associate partner) and attested by a Magistrate 1st Class . The number of JV members shall not exceed two. The Principal/Lead-to-Associate share ratio must clearly be mentioned. In case of JV, the Associate partner must have at least one (01) work/supply order of similar nature as experience record as mentioned above for at least 10% of the estimated cost of the project. (Duly attested work/ supply orders and completion certificates from the concern department shall be provided. Failure of Associate partner to meet this requirement shall render the bid non-responsive.	That the number of Joint Venture (JV) members may be increased from two (02) to three (03). However, the additional (third) JV/associate partner shall be required to fully comply with all applicable eligibility and qualification criteria as specified for JV members in the approved RFP. All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged.
6	The bidder shall supply machinery from internationally recognized, top-tier OEMs of proven quality, performance, reliability and after sales support fully compliant with specified technical requirements and international standards. Machinery originating from established manufacturing regions such as North America, UK, Europe, Japan or South Korea shall be considered in order to maintain uniform standards, quality assurance and consistency in performance. Documentary evidence shall be provided confirming the country of origin and that the equipment is both manufactured and assembled in these regions. GRC Decision The wheel excavators should be assembled by the original OEM facility as per clause B-3.1 (6) of detail technical	- The decision of the GRC restricting eligibility to machinery assembled only at the original OEM facility is set aside. It is held that machinery of internationally recognized OEMs from regions other than those specified shall also remain eligible, provided that all requirements of the bidding documents are fully complied with. - It is further explained that only assembled machinery of internationally recognized OEMs from regions other than those specified shall also remain eligible; provided that such assembly is carried out at an OEM- owned or duly authorized manufacturing facility. The OEM shall certify that such facility maintains equivalent specifications, manufacturing processes, and quality assurance systems,

In case of participation through a Joint Venture (JV), attested copies of CNIC of all JV members shall be provided as part of the bid submission.
14	Machinery Technical Details: - Engine Power: ≥ 140 HP (104.4 KW) - Operating Weight: 15-20 metric tons - Typical Bucket Capacity: 0.5 – 1.0 cubic meters (Must be Heavy Duty). <u>GRC Decision</u> The perception regarding horse power (HP) of wheel excavator as recommended by the Technical Committee (S.# 1) as should be ≥ 140 HP is to be treated as net HP rest of specifications shall remain the same.	That determination of the GRC interpreting the minimum engine power requirement as 140 HP Net is set aside. The capacity of machine shall be Gross Engine Power greater than or equal to 140 HP and Net Engine Power greater or equal to 133 HP. All other technical specifications shall remain the same.
