LETTER OF INVITATION ("PROVISION OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PROJECT HAVING A CUMULATIVE CAPACITY OF 100 MWP SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC (PV) PLANTS AT VARIOUS SITES IN GILGIT-BALTISTAN."

- 1. The Government of Gilgit-Baltistan (GB), through its Water & Power Department, intends to develop a 100 MWp Solar Power Park to address energy shortages and promote renewable energy in the region.
- 2. The hiring process for the selection of Management Consultants out of the public sector entities is also in hand and is likely to be approved by the competent forum. The complexity of the project and harsh climatic conditions require increased focus on the quality of services to maintain international standards and best practices. Accordingly, the services of a Prime consulting firm are required to oversee and review the deliverables from the consultant engaged in the survey, design, and supervision of PV systems. Details of the services are provided in the Terms of Reference.
- 3. The Consultant shall be selected under the Selection Method Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) of the Consulting Firm per the Single Stage Two Envelope (SSTE) Procedure.

- 5. It is mandatory for the proposals to be made using the Standard Forms of the RFP. Proposals that are not in the prescribed format may be discarded. If any information required in the forms is found missing, or written elsewhere, no credit will be given in the relevant section of the evaluation.
- 6. The Consultant should submit details of all of their most relevant assignments for technical evaluation using the prescribed format. Assignments submitted beyond the given number will not be considered.
