TENDER NOTICE

The Provincial Intelligence Fusion & Threat Assessment Centre (PIFTAC), Govt of Gilgit-Baltistan invites sealed bids, under the single-stage two-envelope procedure of the GB-PPRA Rules, 2022, from well-reputed, experienced and registered firms/suppliers for the following sub-heads for the FY 26-27:

S. #	Code	Description of Tender
1	AO-13001	Repair & Maintenance (labour) and supply of spare parts of vehicles & motorcycles
2	AO-9601	Purchase of Plant & Machinery (office equipment, power, solar, CCTV, IT, fire safety)
3	AO-3902	Printing & Publication work
4	AO-3970	Supply of Miscellaneous (Others) items & minor services

EACH TENDER SHALL BE TREATED SEPARATELY. Firms shall apply SEPARATELY for each tender, with a separate bid, separate bid security and separate sealed envelopes clearly marked with the name and code of the tender applied for. A single bid covering more than one tender shall not be entertained.

1. Bidding documents for each tender (detailed terms, mandatory conditions, evaluation criteria and price schedule) may be obtained from the PIFTAC Office, SPU Compound, Sakwar, Gilgit at a non-refundable price of Rs. 1,500/- per tender, or downloaded from the GB-PPRA website (www.gbppra.gov.pk).
2. Possession of a valid vendor number is MANDATORY; only firms/persons holding a valid vendor number should apply, as government payments to vendors are now made online.
3. Only firms fulfilling the mandatory conditions given in the bidding documents of the respective tender, valid registration, NTN and relevant experience are eligible.
4. Bid security equal to 2% of the total quoted price of the respective tender, in the shape of a bank draft/CDR in favour of DDO PIFTAC, must accompany each bid.
5. Bids must reach the PIFTAC Office, SPU Compound, Sakwar, Gilgit on or before 4 Sep, 2026 at 1100 hours (not less than fifteen (15) days from the date of publication, as required under Rule 16 of the GB-PPRA Rules, 2022) and will be opened the same day at 1130 hours in the presence of the bidders or their authorised representatives.
6. The Technical Proposal shall be opened first; the Financial Proposal of only the technically responsive (mandatory-qualified) bidders shall be opened.
7. An affidavit on a stamp paper of Rs. 100/- to the effect that the firm has never been blacklisted must accompany each bid; conditional and optional bids shall be treated as non-responsive.
8. PIFTAC employees/officers and their blood relatives are not eligible to participate.
9. The Procurement Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids under the provisions of the GB-PPRA Rules, 2022.
