SUBJECT: GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE (GRC) AGAINST THE TECHNICAL BID EVALUATION PROCESS OF WORK ADP SCHEME TITLE "PIPE IRRIGATION PROJECT FROM GIRIAKHODO NALLAH TO BAGICHA AND BONDOKHA DISTRICT KHARMANG"

Water Management & Irrigation Secretariat GB received applications of contractor/ Firm namely "M/S Musa Khan Shigiri & Sons JV with Liaqat Wali & Brothers, Khan Engineers & Contractors Gilgit Pvt Ltd, M/S Shahbaz & Sons GB JV M/S Rana M. Nasir, M/S Muhammad Ali Jinnah JV M/S Muhammad Akhtar Mayourdu, Haji Ghulam Hussain & Sons, M/S Muhammad Nawaz Contractor Pvt Ltd and M/S GM Associates" for redressal of the grievances raised against technical bid evaluation process of above noted project. The Secretary Water Management & Irrigation GB vide Notification No S-WM&I-D(2)/2024/1406 dated: 21st January, 2025 constituted Grievance Redressal Committee comprising of the following officers (copy attached as **Annex-A**): -

The Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) assembled under the chairmanship of Deputy Secretary Water Management Department GB in his office on 27th January, 2025. Detail deliberations were made regarding the complaints of the following aggrieved bidder against Technical Bid evaluation process for above work.

BACKGORUND:

The procurement committee consist of the following Members.

- Notice issued for inviting Technical Proposals from interested Firms through wide publicity in Newspaper & PPRA vide their Notice No.DOWM&I-DEV-ADP-2024-25,

dated 23rd Dec, 2024 and Corrigendum issued vide GBPPRA Ref No is TSE.20241230538.

- In response of that advertisement 19 Nos Firms submitted their technical and financial proposals to participate in the bidding process and the procurement committee opened the technical bids in presence of the bidders and 03 bidders qualified for the financial bid opening while remaining 16 bidders were disqualified by the Procurement Committee.
- The Technical Bid evaluation report was prepared and signed by the procurement committee, approved by Deputy Director Water Management District Kharmang as Chairman procurement committee and subsequently uploaded in PPRA web site vide PPRA Ref No. TSE-20250120604. (Copy attached as Annex-B)

Out of 16 disqualified bidders, 07 Nos aggrieved bidders Namely "1. Musa Khan Shigiri & Sons JV with Liaqat Wali & Brothers, 2. Khan Engineers & Contractors Gilgit Pvt Ltd, 3. M/S Shahbaz & Sons GB JV M/S Rana M. Nasir, 4. M/S Muhammad Ali Jinnah JV M/S Muhammad Akhtar Mayourdu, 5. Haji Ghulam Hussain & Sons, 6. M/S Muhammad Nawaz Contractor Pvt Ltd and 7. M/S GM Associates" have approached/filed complaint to the Secretary WM&I/PAO against the Technical Bid evaluation report. The competent authority constituted GRC vide above referred notification.

PROCEEDINGS:

On the basis of the applicant's reservations, the GRC has thoroughly examined the technical bid documents of the all 07 aggrieved bidder mentioned above and observed the following facts and findings:

1. Musa Khan Shigiri & Sons JV with Liaqat Wali & Brothers

On the basis of the applicant reservations, the GRC has thoroughly examined the technical bid documents of the "Musa Khan Shigiri & Sons JV with Liaqat Wali & Brothers" and observed the following facts and findings:

FACTS & FINDINGS:

As per mandatory clause of the bid document, all firm were asked to provide No backlisting and No Litigation Certificate duly attested by Magistrate (Latest date and Original) but as per technical proposal of the bidder, "Musa Khan Shigiri & Sons JV with Liaqat Wali & Brothers" has not provided the original No backlisting and No Litigation Certificate attested by Magistrate.

As per observation of the bidder mentioned in his application dated 20th January, 2025, the firm **Musa Khan Shigiri & Sons JV with Liaqat Wali & Brothers** has not been invited during the technical bid opening process while as per rule the department has already published the reschedule/corrigendum vide GB PPRA TSE-20241230538 on dated 30th December, 2024. (Copy attached Annex-B). As per corrigendum the closing date of tender was 14th January, 2025 and due to local holyday on 14th January,



2025 (13th Rajab Birthday of Hazart Ali AS) tender has been opened on very next working day as the clause has already been mentioned in NIT of dated 23rd Dec, 2024.

PROCEEDINGS:

2. Khan Engineers & Contractors Gilgit Pvt Ltd

On the basis of the applicant reservations, the GRC has thoroughly examined the technical bid documents of the "Khan Engineers & Contractors Gilgit Pvt Ltd" and observed the following facts and findings:

FACTS & FINDINGS:

As per mandatory clause of the bid document all firm are asked to provide No backlisting and No Litigation Certificate duly attested by Magistrate (Latest date and Original) but as per technical proposal of the bidder, **Khan Engineers & Contractors Gilgit Pvt Ltd** has not provided the mandatory document i.e original No backlisting and No Litigation Certificate attested by Magistrate.

PROCEEDINGS:

3. M/S Shahbaz & Sons GB JV M/S Rana M. Nasir

On the basis of the applicant reservations, the GRC has thoroughly examined the technical bid documents of the "M/S Shahbaz & Sons GB JV M/S Rana M. Nasir" and observed the following facts and findings:

FACTS & FINDINGS:

As per the technical bid document of the firm **M/S Shahbaz & Sons GB**, the bidder has provided the original stamp paper showing the JV of two firms **M/S Shahbaz & Sons GB** as leading partner and **M/S Rana M. Nasir** as 2nd JV partner. But the bidder is not fulfilling the all requirements of JV i.e not provided the PEC registration and No Blacklisting and No litigation certificate of the 2nd partner M/S Rana M. Nasir as the same are mandatory clauses. Beside this, the bidder has provided the original No Blacklisting and No litigation certificate which is not attested by the Magistrate as per mandatory clause of the technical bid document.

4. M/S Muhammad Ali Jinnah JV M/S Muhammad Akhtar Mayourdu

On the basis of the applicant reservations, the GRC has thoroughly examined the technical bid documents of the "M/S Muhammad Ali Jinnah JV M/S Muhammad Akhtar Mayourdu" and observed the following facts and findings:

FACTS & FINDINGS:

As per mandatory clause of the bid document, all firms are asked to provide No backlisting and No litigation Certificate duly attested by Magistrate (Latest date and Original) but as per technical proposal of the bidder, "M/S Muhammad Ali Jinnah JV M/S Muhammad Akhtar Mayourdu" has not provided the original No backlisting and No litigation Certificate attested by Magistrate which is the mandatory clause of the technical bid document.

5. M/S Haji Ghulam Hussain & Sons

On the basis of the applicant reservations, the GRC has thoroughly examined the technical bid documents of the "M/S Haji Ghulam Hussain & Sons" and observed the following facts and findings:

FACTS & FINDINGS:

Personals capabilities:

The bidder has been disqualified by the tender committee under the Personal Capabilities. However, the aggrieved bidder has submitted application without mentioning the application date and without signature of the applicant but as per rule the submission of application for GRC to PAO must have proper date and signature of aggrieved bidder which should be received within the 07 days after display of technical evaluation report on PPRA website.

6. M/S Muhammad Nawaz Contractor Pvt Ltd

On the basis of the applicant reservations, the GRC has thoroughly examined the technical bid documents of the "M/S Muhammad Nawaz Contractor Pvt Ltd" and observed the following facts and findings:

FACTS & FINDINGS:

Personals capabilities:

The technical proposal of bidder was checked under the section of personals capabilities and found that bidder has provided the CV of Civil Engineer Registered with PEC as per requirement but the bidder has not provided the appointment letter of Civil Engineer Waqas Muhammad therefore 1.5 marks may be given to the bidder under clause 3.2.3 (Personal Capabilities) at Sr. 1 (i) out of total 06 marks.

Furthermore, the bidder has provided the certificate of Diploma of Associate Engineer (Civil Technology) in respect of Mr. Zeeshan s/o Shaukat Zaman whereas the experience certificate of DAE personal is not provided in technical bid document. Therefore 01 mark obtained under the clause 3.2.3 (Personal Capabilities) at Sr. 1 (ii) out of total 04 marks.

7. M/S GM Associates

On the basis of the applicant reservations, the GRC has thoroughly examined the technical bid documents of the "M/S GM Associates" and observed the following facts and findings:

FACTS & FINDINGS:

Personals capabilities:


The technical proposal of bidder was checked under the section of personals capabilities and found that that bidder has provided the appointment letters of Professional and Registered Engineers without mentioning the date on appointment letter. The attached appointment letters do not show the period of hired Engineers so the appointment letter cannot be considered for evaluation.



RECOMMENDATIONS

As per re-evaluation technical bid document of the 07 aggrieved bidders, the GRC has recommended the following:

- i. The bidders **Musa Khan Shigiri & Sons JV with Liaqat Wali & Brothers, Khan Engineers & Contractors Gilgit Pvt Ltd and M/S Muhammad Ali Jinnah JV M/S Muhammad Akhtar Mayourdu**, have not provided the original No backlisting and No litigation Certificate attested by Magistrate. Whereas, the bidder **M/S Shahbaz & Sons GB JV M/S Rana M. Nasir** has provided the original stamp paper showing the JV of two firms **M/S Shahbaz & Sons GB** as leading partner and **M/S Rana M. Nasir** as 2nd JV partner. Required document of the 2nd partner is not provided. Original No Blacklisting and No litigation certificate is provided which is not attested by the Magistrate as per mandatory clause of the technical bid document. Keeping in view, the plea of the above bidders are hereby rejected and the decision of tender opening committee is upheld.
- ii. **The bidder Haji Ghulam Hussain & Sons** has submitted application without mentioning the application date and without signature of the applicant but as per rule the submission of application for GRC to PAO must have proper date and signature of aggrieved bidder which also must be received within 07 days after display of technical evaluation report on PPRA website. Therefore, the plea of bidder is hereby rejected and the decision of tender opening committee is upheld.
- iii. **M/S Muhammad Nawaz Contractor Pvt Ltd**
Under clause 3.2.3 (Personal Capabilities) at Sr. 1 (i) marks are increased from 0 to 1,5 out of total 06 marks and Under the clause 3.2.3 (Personal Capabilities) at Sr. 1 (ii) marks are increased from 0-1 out of total 04 marks. After thoroughly reviewed of al document, the bidder is failed to achieve the passing marks under clause Persona Capabilities. Therefore, the plea of bidder is hereby rejected and the decision of tender opening committee is upheld.



- iv. The bidder **M/S GM Associates** has provided the appointment letters of Professional and Registered Engineers without mentioning the date on appointment letter. The attached appointment letters do not show the period of hired Engineer so the appointment letter cannot be considered for evaluation. Therefore, the plea of bidder is hereby rejected and the decision of tender opening committee is upheld.


The tender opening committee may proceed further as per PPRA rules.
