**GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Tender received after the stipulated date and time shall not be entertained.
2. Bid security/CDR from a scheduled bank must accompany the bid; otherwise, the offer shall be rejected.
3. Only registered firms having valid licenses and registrations shall be eligible to participate.
4. Quotations must be submitted on the firm's original letterhead, duly signed and stamped.
5. If the tender opening date is declared a public/local holiday, the tender shall be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
6. Rates quoted must be computerized and free from cutting, overwriting, or erasing.
7. The bidder shall submit an original and valid affidavit regarding non-blacklisting and absence of litigation against the firm/company.
8. The procuring agency reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in accordance with applicable procurement rules.
9. The successful bidder shall furnish a Performance Security equal to ten percent (10%) of the annual estimated contract value within the prescribed period after issuance of the Letter of Acceptance.
10. Tender document having specific terms and conditions are available, which can be obtained from the office of undersigned during duty hours on written request with treasury challan of tender document fee (Rs.12000/-).
11. Without treasury challan of tender fee, no tender copy will be issued.
12. The successful bidder shall establish and maintain a medicine dispensing facility within Gilgit Cardiac

**SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**1. SCOPE OF WORK**

The successful bidder shall:

- Ensure uninterrupted 24/7 availability of SSP medicines and surgical items.
- Maintain adequate stock throughout the contract period (only SSP).
- Establish and maintain a medicine dispensing facility within Gilgit Cardiac Hospital Gilgit or within a radius of 100 meters from the hospital premises (only SSP).
- If such facility is not available at the time of bidding, it shall be established within TWO (02) days after award of contract (only SSP).
- Replace expired, damaged, recalled, or substandard products immediately.
- Maintain computerized inventory, dispensing, billing, and patient records (only SSP).
- Facilitate verification and audit by SSP, State Life Insurance Corporation, and Hospital Management (only SSP).

**2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

The bidder must possess:

- Valid Drug Sale License.
- Valid Registration with DRAP where applicable.
- Affidavit of Non-Blacklisting (up to date and original).
- Computerized Inventory Management System (only SSP).
- Cold-chain storage facility where applicable.
- The firm must have a qualified pharmacist on regular basis or under continuous employment for at least one year. A copy of the appointment order or employment contract shall be provided as proof.

**3. QUALITY ASSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

The supplier shall ensure:

- Supply of genuine DRAP-registered medicines only.
- Minimum residual shelf life of 75% at the time of supply.
- Original manufacturer packing and labeling.
- Batch traceability and quality compliance.
- Compliance with cold-chain and storage requirements.
- Availability of certificates of analysis whenever required.
- Immediate replacement of any product declared substandard by DRAP or any competent authority.

#### **4. PRESCRIPTION COMPLIANCE**

- Medicines shall be supplied strictly according to the prescription of the treating physician/consultant.
- No medicine, brand, formulation, strength, dosage form, or quantity shall be substituted without written approval of the prescribing physician.
- Surgical items, consumables, implants, and sutures shall be supplied strictly as prescribed.
- Unauthorized substitution shall be treated as a serious breach of contract.

#### **5. SSP BILLING, VERIFICATION & AUDIT CONTROL**

- Medicines, surgical items, and laboratory services shall be provided only against approved SSP prescriptions and treatment plans.
- Patient-wise computerized records shall be maintained.
- Duplicate billing, overbilling; false claims, inflated rates, or billing of unprovided items shall be strictly prohibited.
- Hospital Audit Committee may verify any claim before submission to SSP/State Life.
- All records shall be produced on demand for audit and inspection.

#### **6. PERFORMANCE SECURITY**

**The successful bidder shall furnish a Performance Security equal to ten percent (10%) of the annual estimated contract value within the prescribed period after issuance of the Letter of Acceptance.**

The Performance Security shall be in the form of a Call Deposit Receipt (CDR) or Bank Guarantee issued by a Scheduled Bank operating in Pakistan.

Failure to furnish the required Performance Security within the stipulated period shall result in cancellation of the award and forfeiture of bid security.

#### **7. AWARD OF CONTRACT**

The contract shall be awarded to the bidder who:

- Meets all technical requirements.
- Qualifies the eligibility criteria.
- Offers the most advantageous evaluated bid.

The Procuring Agency reserves the right to reject any or all bids in accordance with applicable procurement rules.
