2. Tender documents containing detailed terms and conditions, specifications, requirements, and scope of work may be obtained from the office during office working hours on payment of a non-refundable fee of Rs. 10,000/- through Treasury Challan.
3. In case the date of opening falls on a public holiday, the bids shall be opened on the next working day at the same time in the Finance Department, GB Secretariat.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- i. Earnest money as specified against each head shall be attached with the bid in the form of Call Deposit in favour of Drawing and Disbursement Officer(DDO),P&D Department.
- ii. Incomplete bids or those submitted without supporting documents shall not be entertained. Submission of false information shall render the bidder liable to legal action.
- iii. An affidavit on stamp paper of Rs. 100/- (original, prepared after the date of publication of this notice) must be attached with the bid, affirming that the bidder has never been blacklisted by any Government, SemiGovernment Organization, or GBPPRA.
- iv. The bids shall be opened in the presence of vendors or their authorized representatives on the date and time specified above. Vendors who have submitted bids by hand or through courier service shall also be treated as present during the bid opening process even if not physically present.
- v. Vendors must possess minimum five years' relevant experience for items at Category No. B,C,& D and ten years' relevant experience for item at Category S.No. A. Relevant supply orders, experience certificates, or other verifiable documentary proof shall be attached with the bid.
- vi. Single-stage, two-envelope bidding procedure shall be adopted, and evaluation shall be carried out on the basis of a 70:30 ratio, wherein 70% shall be for technical proposal and 30% to financial proposal.
- vii. The department reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids according to GB PPRA Rule-36(1).
- viii. The Rates must be quoted in comprised printed format.
- ix. For Category C items single stage single envelop procedure will be followed.
