

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Sealed computerized tenders, application on letter heads of the firm along with attested copies of Form "C/H" should be reached to the Directorate of Fisheries GB on or before the date & time mentioned against each and shall be opened in presence of bidders or their authorized representatives on the mentioned date, venue and time.
2. Bidders Registered with FBR should submit only the attested copies of registration form.
3. Two (2) % call deposit (CDR) (scheduled bank only) of the quoted bid in favor of Director Fisheries GB is required along with financial proposals and the photocopy of same CDR must be attached with Technical Bid also.
4. The Director Fisheries GB/ Project Director reserve the right to reject all bids or proposal at any time prior to the acceptance of bid or proposal as prescribed under rule GB PPRA & 33(1) of PPRA Rule 2004.
5. The bidders offering rates for cold storage items should have experience of purchase , installation & operation of cold storage and authorized dealership/JV from the relevant company /Firm /agency dealing with the mentioned items.
6. **Lot based** bidding procedure will be adopted for above mentioned tenders.
7. The procuring agency has the right to inspect, test where necessary and reject the goods/items after arrivals at the purchaser's delivery point. The supplier shall either replace the rejected items/goods or make alterations necessary to meet the requirements free of cost to the purchasers. The bidder bound to deliver and install the items to the mentioned district in the supply order by the procuring agency.
8. The bidding criteria of "Single stage Two Envelopes" bidding procedure (Technical and Financial) as per GB PPRA Rules & Rule 36 (b) of PPRA Rules 2004 shall be applied.
  - (i) The bid shall comprise a single package containing two separate envelopes. Each envelop shall contain separately, the technical and financial proposal.
  - (ii) The envelopes shall be marked as "TECHNICAL PROPOSAL" and "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL" in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion. Initially, only the envelope marked "TECHNICAL PROPOSAL" shall be opened.
  - (iii) The envelope marked as "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL" shall be opened only of technically qualified firms; the qualifying marks of the technical evaluation will be decided by the tender opening committee.
9. In case of any unforeseen reasons on the bid submission and opening date, the tender shall be opened on the next working day at the same place/time.
10. The offered Bid (lot based) shall be rejected in case of below/ above the reasonable market rates
11. The shortlisted contractor will bound to provide the required needful additional items as per market rates which are not included in the tender documents for the financial year 2024-25.
