



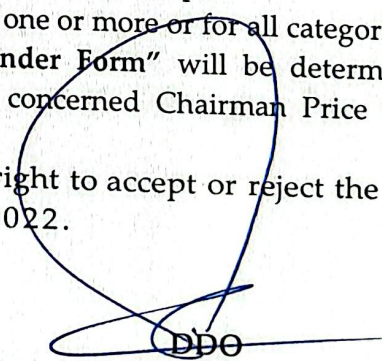

 - ii. Tenders with incomplete supporting documents shall not be accepted, and furnishing incorrect information shall be liable to legal action.
 - iii. The firm/contractor winning the bid shall be bound to supply the items to Deputy Commissioner Office till 30th June, 2027.
 - iv. Firms quoting irrational/unjustifiable/inappropriate rates (even of a single item) with respect to market rates, shall not be considered.
 - v. Name of category must be written in bold on the sealed envelope.
 - vi. A firm/contractor/supplier may offer tenders for one or more or for all categories.
 - vii. The rates of items if not covered in the "Tender Form" will be determined in accordance with the retail price fixed by the concerned Chairman Price Control Committee.
 - viii. Deputy Commissioner Office reserves the right to accept or reject the tender according to the relevant rule of GB PPRA, 2022.
