Parks & Wildlife Department Government of Gilgit-Baltistan invites sealed tenders from Registered firms/companies for “**DIGITAL TICKET SYSTEM FOR NATIONAL PARKS & PROTECTED AREAS IN GILGIT BALTISTAN**” at its office in Gilgit.”

1. Only registered IT firms (both SECP and PSEB) possessing a minimum of 3 years of experience in the IT sector and strong technical and financial standing, can apply for Digital Ticket System and hardware project. **(Serial 1)**
2. Firms, authorized dealers, Suppliers possessing minimum two years' similar experience and having both form C and SECP registration are eligible for Solar and surveillance project. **(Serial 2)**
3. The tender shall follow the Single Stage-Two Envelope procedure as per Section 39(b) of the GB PPRA Rules 2022. Bidders must submit one package containing two separate envelopes: one for the Technical Proposal and one for the Financial Proposal.
4. The bids will be evaluated using Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS), with 70% for the technical proposal and 30% for the financial proposal.
5. Firms must score at least 70% in the technical proposal to qualify in technical stage. The financial proposal will be opened in the presence of authorized representatives in next stage.
6. The bidders must submit a **defined Call Deposit (CDR)** from any scheduled bank, in favor of Chief Conservator Parks & Wildlife Gilgit-Baltistan, attached to the technical proposal.
7. The bidders must have developed at least two software projects in public/private sector.
8. Bidders must deliver a formal presentation to the bidding committee on the development of the Digital Ticket Software and allied components, incorporating a comprehensive flowchart.
9. The Bidders must have local presence in Gilgit-Baltistan with established office and contact numbers.
10. Tender documents can be obtained from the undersigned during office hours upon payment of a non-refundable fee mentioned above through Treasury Challan.
11. The Department reserves the right to accept or reject the tender as per PPRA or cancel the bidding without assigning any reason.
