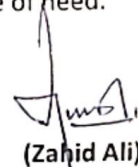
TERMS & CONDITIONS

The terms and conditions of Tender for procurement/repairs of items are as under:

The quotations/bids shall be received up to **(Monday, 17th August-2026)** at **(11:00 AM)** and shall be opened on the same date **at 11:45 am** in the presence of bidders or their authorized representative.

- i. Tender documents/complete specifications and details of the items as well as the specific conditions applied against the particular item can be obtained from the office of the undersigned by paying bid documents fee Rs.1000/- (non refundable) during office hours.
(Address: Admn Section office of the Accountant General, GB Konodass, Gilgit).
- ii. a) **Single stage – one envelope procedure will be adopted.** - Each bid shall comprise one single envelope containing, separately, financial proposal and technical proposal (if any). All bids received shall be opened and evaluated in the manner prescribed in the bidding document.

- iii. Quotations must be accompanied by (3%) of the total offered price in the shape of **Call Deposit Receipt (CDR)** as bid security in the name of **DDO Accountant General Gilgit-Baltistan**. The sealed quotations/bids reached **without 3% CDR** will not be entertained.
- iv. There will be no compromise on the quantity and quality of the items after acceptance of the bid.
- v. Submission of any false statement/document and concealing of information is likely to disqualify the bidder at any stage of procurement process.
- vi. Bidders must provide an **affidavit on Rs. 50 stamp paper** duly attested by Magistrate 1st class that the contractor or his firm has not been blacklisted by any Govt. Organization.
- vii. The contractors/bidders must have their own **shop/showroom/workshop** as well as past experience for supply of such items as mentioned in his bid documents.
- viii. Office of the **Accountant General Gilgit-Baltistan** reserves the right to **accept/reject** any of all bids without assigning any reason before award of contracts.
- ix. An agreement will be executed with the successful bidder for procurements to be made on need basis throughout the **Financial year 2026-27**.
- x. Supply Orders will be issued to successful bidders specifically **(subjected to the condition)** as per availability of funds and official requirements.
- xi. All kinds of Govt. Taxes (**applicable if any**) will be deducted as per rules.
- xii. Tender will be valid up to **30-06-2027**, extendable as per rules in case of need.
