RE-TENDER NOTICE

1. Gilgit-Baltistan Police Department invites sealed re-tenders from registered and eligible firms for supply, installation and commissioning of Forensic equipment/items, Hardware, Chemicals and Consumable items for "Crime Scene Investigation Unit & Latent fingerprint Lab" under the project titled "Gilgit-Baltistan Digital Forensic Lab".
2. The Re-Tender is being issued due to cancellation/ non-responsiveness/ technical reasons of the previous tender.
3. The successful bidder will be responsible for delivery, installation, testing, commissioning and operational deployment of all goods/equipment/items in "Gilgit-Baltistan Digital Forensic Lab" through their qualified technical staff.
4. The procurement shall be conducted under GB PPRA Rules 39(b) "Single Stage Two Envelop Procedure".
5. Each bid must be accompanied by the bid security equivalent to 3% of bid cost in the shape of Bank Draft/Pay Order from any scheduled bank in favor of DIG HQs Gilgit-Baltistan on or before 21st January, 2026.
6. Bids shall be received up to 21st January, 2026 at 1100 hours and opened on the same day at 1130 in the conference Hall Central Police Office (CPO), Gilgit, in presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives, subject to completion of 15 days of publication of the tender notice in the newspapers/PPRA Website.
7. Bidders are advised to quote one rate per item, multiple rates shall render the bid non-responsive.
8. Conditional will be rejected outright.
9. Interested firms may obtain the bidding documents containing detailed specifications, terms & conditions of respective items, etc from Development Branch CPO, Gilgit, during office hours on written request on the firms' letter head, up to one day before bid opening, on payment of the Tender Fee i.e. 10,000/-.
10. Request for provision of the tender documents through the Post Office or TCS. All related expenditures shall be borne by the firms, and the department shall not be responsible for any delay or non-receipt of the said documents.
11. Upon acceptance, the successful bidder shall execute the project strictly in accordance with the Contract Agreement.
12. No claims on account of taxes, travelling, royalty, and transportation shall be admissible.
13. The Tender Committee reserves the right to reject or accept any or all technical and financial bids as per provisions of the bidding documents and GB PPRA Rules.
